
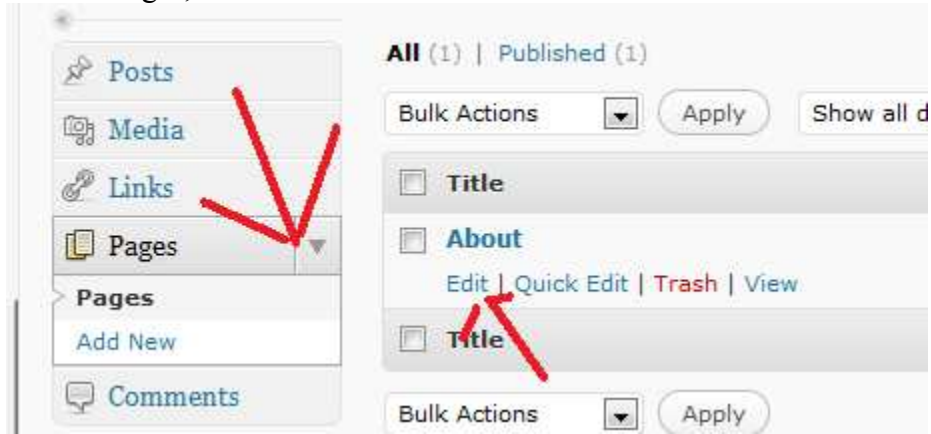


Setting up WordPress for SD Website

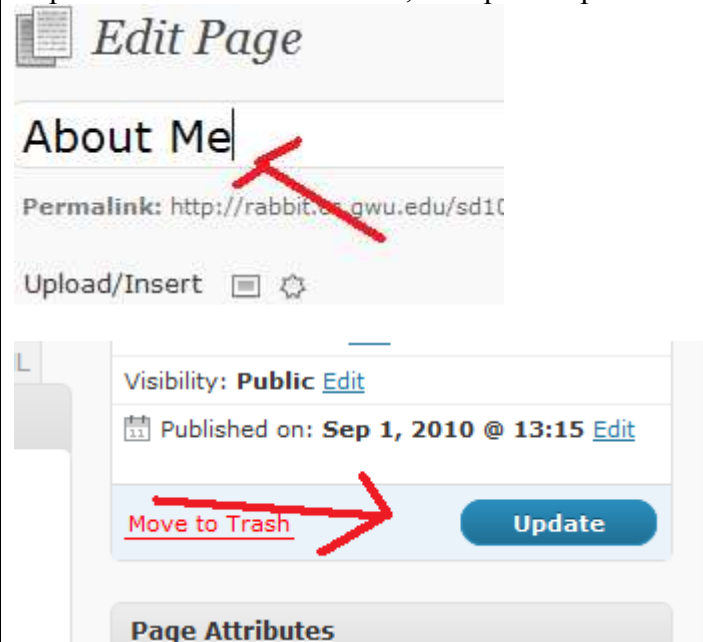
1. Check your email	You should have received an email with the subject “New SD10 Sites Site: Senior Design 2010” Double check to make sure you can log in
2. Activate your theme	<p>On the left dashboard click Themes</p>  <p>Scroll down and activate Repousse</p> <p>Repousse 1.0 by Viva Themes <i>Clean business theme</i> Activate Preview</p> <p>All of this theme's files are located in <code>/themes/repousse</code>.</p>

3. Add the necessary class pages

Choose Pages, Then Edit the about



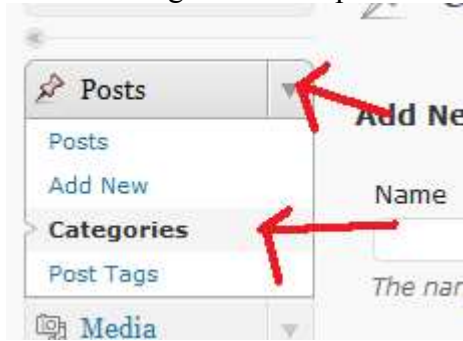
Replace About with About me, then press Update



Click Add New and add "Home Page" and "Documentation"

4. Add blog

Choose Categories under posts:

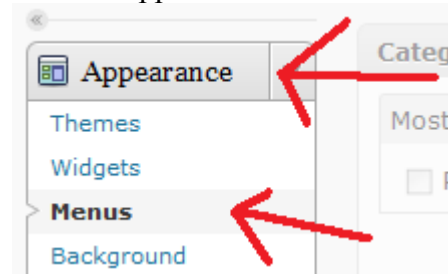


Quick edit uncategorized and rename it Project Blog

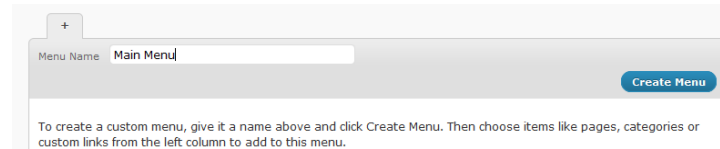


5. Setup the menu

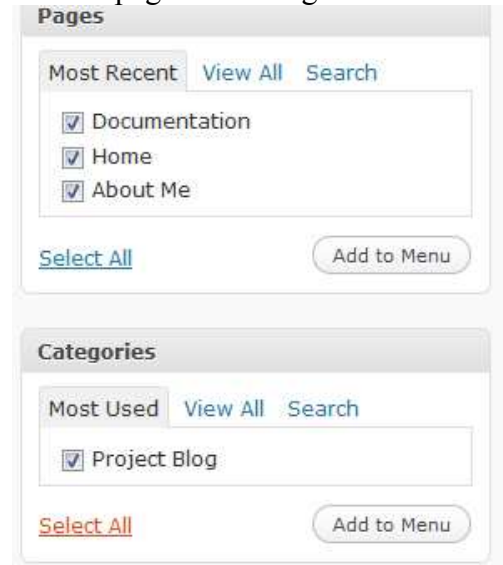
Choose Appearance -> menu



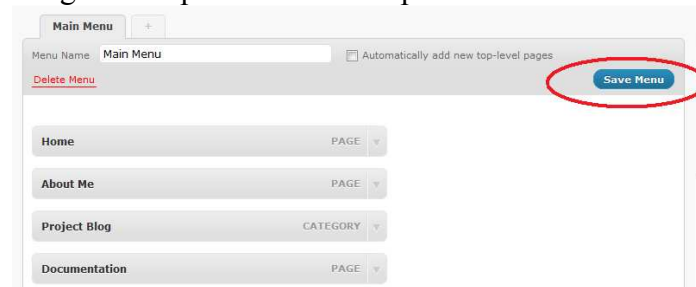
Enter a menu name and click Create Menu




Add all pages and categories to the menu:



Drag and drop to reorder then press Save Menu




Choose the main menu and footer menu options and press save




6. Set your page title

Select Settings -> General




Set your site title and tagline






Scroll to the bottom and press OK

7. Set your home page

Choose Settings->Reading, then a static page and your home page

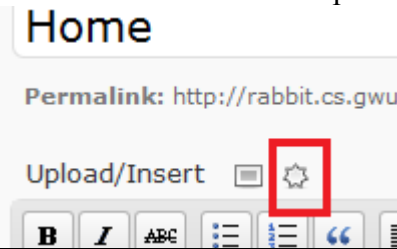


Save changes

<p>8. Set security options</p>	<p>Set Settings > Discussion as follows:</p> 
<p>9. Set your side bar</p>	<p>Choose Appearance -> Widgets</p>  <p>Now you can drag and drop widgets to your side bar. We recommend a Text Widget and a Recent Posts Widget to your Right Sidebar</p> 
<p>10. Adding content</p>	<p>To add blog posts, simply click on Posts->add new</p> <p>To edit a page you can use the editor provided or type in HTML</p>

Pages can either display the side bar or be full width. The Template in Page Attributes toggles this option)

To add files click on the Upload Media option
